Improvements to the Playgrounds during 2019....

Although the playgrounds on the estate are popular and well used, they are in need of investment

Now plans are at an advanced stage to put in new equipment in the playground between Beattie and Bonsor Houses with money from the Council's playgrounds budget. This should be underway during early 2019.

We have also met with the Nine Elms Regeneration team and funds will be made available by developers for improvements to the other play areas following discussions with residents next year.
